RULES OF COMPETITION

1. Media: Paintings and drawings ONLY in any full-color media and of any size. No photographs, no giclee.
2. Artists do not have to be residents of Clayton and must be 18 or older.
3. Entries must be ORIGINAL artwork only.
4. Original art is defined as one-of-a-kind art, created by the artist's hand and not to include copied subjects from other artists' work.
5. Entry fee \$35 (\$25 for Clayton Visual Arts members); for 1 or 2 entries.
6. Entry deadline: 5 pm Mon., April 24, 2017 (form & fee in our hands).
7. Deliver art: Mon, May 1, 11 am-1 pm & 4-6 pm, to Clayton Center, 111 E. 2nd St.
8. All work must be WIRED & ready to hang – NO EXCEPTIONS. Max weight 35 lbs.
9. Clayton Visual Arts reserves the right to disqualify any work whose content, in its judgment, does not meet generally accepted community standards of good taste.
10. Clayton Visual Arts and The Clayton Center are not responsible for loss or damage of artwork. Artists

should insure their work if they desire.
